Re: **MIDDLE AGE TRAINING - Online**

*“For the perfecting of the saints unto the work of the ministry,
unto the building up of the Body of Christ”. (Eph. 4:12)*

Dear Saints,

God needs man, as much as man needs God, to accomplish His economy. Thus, there is a need to train many vessels who may become normal, living and functioning members in the God’s house, the church. For this purpose, the urgent need today is to perfect the saints unto the work of the ministry so that, through all the saints carrying out their function, the Body of Christ may be built-up.

This is the noble purpose of the **Middle Age Training (MAT)**. And in consideration of those who are not able to join the live/in-person training, we have this **Middle Age Training – Online via Zoom**. This term will cover **MAT-Module 3** during the period **August 15, 2026 until January 16, 2027**.

The MAT – Online:

1. There are two terms of MAT every year. The first term is a live/in-person training held during seasonal break on March or April, and the second term is held online via Zoom, on August to January. Each term covers a complete module of 43-45 lessons.
2. There are two class sessions every week, i.e. every Wednesday and Saturday evening, from 7:30pm-9:30pm. Trainees are expected to log in 30 minutes earlier. Class session starts on time.
3. An essential part of the MAT-Online is that the Trainees are organized into small groups for daily prayer and pursuit of the word.
4. To qualify for the training, the applicants must be:
 - At least six months with regular church life
 - 30 to 65 years old
 - Loving the Lord and consecrated to complete the training
 - Able to understand **English language. Lessons are delivered in English.**
 - Able to do **basic operation of Zoom** and other similar online platforms.
 - Able to cope with the daily living schedule and cooperate with the training team
 - Willing to share the gospel and shepherd the new ones, online or in person.
5. MAT modules taken online or on actual live training are credited likewise. The trainee may graduate upon completion of all the four modules, with **at least 1 module taken in-person**. The Training requires at least 90% attendance to credit a module. **Missed lessons or incomplete modules need to be completed thru make-up classes under the guidance of the training assistants.**
6. MAT Graduation Meetings will be held during in-person training only. There will be no graduation program for this online module.

MAT Registration:

- Consecration Agreement
- Registration Donation

To cover administration costs, the contribution fee of every local trainee is One thousand Pesos (PHP1,500) per term. Trainees from overseas location may join with a contribution fee of One hundred US Dollars (USD 150) per person per term.
